- January exams week begins on Tuesday January 21^{st.}
- Our exam times are mornings (am) 8:15 to 11:15 and afternoons (pm) 12:15 to 3:15. Students should plan on arriving at least 15 minutes prior to scheduled exam time. *This does not apply to bus students*.
- UNIFORM STATEWIDE LAST ADMISSION TIMES are: 10am for morning exam and 2pm for an afternoon exam. These times are inflexible for Regents Exams!
- Busses will run their normal schedule. Please contact your local district in regards to bus run information and scheduling.
 - Uniforms are not required. However, students are expected to dress appropriately. We want students to be comfortable but their style of dress should be appropriately modest. No hats are allowed, shorts should be an appropriate length and males are to be clean-shaven.
 - There is a regular lunch program during exam weeks.
